Reminder of Odd Even Restriction

Your water system gets its water from wells located in the Town of Litchfield and from Pennichuck's water treatment plant in Nashua. In the early summer of 2021 two of the three Litchfield wells (capable of producing 790,000 gallons of water per day) had to be shut off due to elevated levels of PFAS. These two wells are still out of service and the loss of the capacity from those wells, in conjunction with the warm, dry late spring and early summer, have put a strain on the ability to meter the current water supply demands for your water system and the ability to deliver adequate water to meet the elevated water demands that began several weeks ago.

There have been reports that customers are using outside water every day, which is a violation of your water systems odd/even watering restrictions. It is essential that all customers abide by the odd/even restrictions so that the summer demand does not outstrip the ability to supply water which could result in a system wide water outage. To help customers understand the magnitude of usage in your water system, the typical usage in your water system increases from an average of about 350,000 gallons per day during the months when water is not used outside up to about 750,000 gallons per day during a typical summer. At present we are seeing demands approaching 1 million gallons per day. We are asking all customers to moderate their outside usage and to use water outside their homes only on their allowed outside usage days. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
