

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) hereby provides initial notice of its decision to provide High Hazard Potential Dam (HHPD) grant program funding for an action located in a floodplain. Funding would be provided through the New Hampshire Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to Pennichuck Water Works to rehabilitate its Bowers Pond Dam.

The proposed action at Bowers Pond Dam operated by the applicant is located off Al Paul Lane in Merrimack, NH straddling Nashua, NH to address dam safety deficiencies. The project will include improvements to the auxiliary spillway, demolition of the existing intake structure, and installation of new weir gates and stoplog bays.

The project is within a mapped special flood hazard area (100-year floodplain). Maps of the floodplain area are available upon request.
